Children are invited to dress up as their favourite book character on this special day and take part in a Costume Parade at **9.15am** in the school hall, parents are invited to watch this.

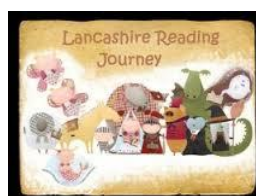
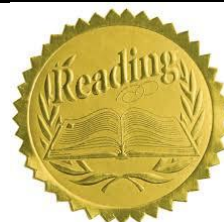
