Dear Parents and Carers of children in Years 1 to 5

As part of your child's outdoor and adventurous strand of their P.E. curriculum, the school has arranged for each class to take part in an exciting day at Hothersall Lodge, a Lancashire Outdoor Education Centre. On the day, the children will enjoy activities such as canoeing, climbing, caving, archery and team building challenges. All of these events will be led by qualified instructors from Hothersall Lodge and will be age appropriate. You will be pleased to learn the cost of the day, including travel, will be funded by the school's P.E. Sports Premium Funding. Each class will enjoy a full day at the centre which will take place week beginning Monday 29<sup>th</sup> April. Please make a note of the day in which your child's class will be attending:

**Monday 29<sup>th</sup> April – Year 1**  
**Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> April – Year 2**  
**Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> May – Year 3**  
**Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> May – Year 4**  
**Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> May – Year 5**

On each day, the children will travel by coach, leaving at **8:30am** and returning to school at approximately **4:30pm**. These times will allow the children to get the maximum amount of learning experience and excitement out of their day. Please arrive at school at **8:15am** for registration on the day of your child's visit.

On the day your child will need to wear their school tracksuit and P.E. kit. They will definitely require a coat and footwear which has a good sole. We also ask that they bring with them a complete change of clothes and footwear should any items that they are wearing get wet. This is purely precautionary due to weather and we don't intend to get wet as the canoeing is aimed to be a 'dry session'.

Unless you are eligible for a free school meal, please send a packed lunch in a named bag, the Hothersall Lodge staff will include breaks during the day when they will provide drinks.

Although this is a compulsory part of your child's P.E. curriculum you will need to return the Form 3B Parental Consent for Type B visits which you will find in your child's book bag this afternoon and return it school by Friday 26<sup>th</sup> April.
