

Dear Parents & Carers,

You may or may not have seen the announcement yesterday from Lancashire County Council advising all Lancashire schools NOT to open to more children on 1st June. If you have not already seen this via social media then the full statement can be found below.

Obviously, the current situation is different from one region of the country to another and this means that the response from each local authority needs to be tailored to the situation found in each area. I am sure that the Director of Public Health and Wellbeing, Dr Sakthi Karunathini, has not taken this decision lightly. With the wellbeing of our children, staff and yourselves being the priority, it would be wrong of us to go against this advice. Please Note: any information announced by the Government later today will not impact upon this advice.

In light of this, our plan has changed, **wider opening of our school will not take place** from next Tuesday 2nd June. Lancashire County Council has promised to keep us updated and likewise, any information we receive will be shared with you all.
